**JOEL R. KLEMMER** is an executive procurement leader and institutional governance architect whose authority has operated across national defense, healthcare, communications, and infrastructure systems within the United States Army, the Defense Information Systems Agency, the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers, and the Department of Veterans Affairs. He has exercised unlimited federal contracting warrant authority in billion-dollar acquisition environments where capital allocation, statutory compliance, and audit integrity are inseparable from mission execution.

As Division Chief and Supervisory Contracting Officer within the U.S. Army Test and Evaluation Command, Mr. Klemmer directed a \$2B+ enterprise acquisition portfolio and led more than 50 contracting professionals responsible for lifecycle execution of mission-critical defense programs under sustained executive and fiscal scrutiny. His leadership reinforced acquisition discipline, preserved governance continuity, and safeguarded capital movement within complex operational systems.

At the Defense Information Systems Agency, he served as primary contracting authority within billion-dollar IDIQ structures supporting national command, communications, and intelligence-support infrastructure. His acquisition actions withstood GAO protest review and advanced measurable improvements in procurement performance within high-complexity mission environments.

Within the Department of Veterans Affairs National Acquisition Center, Mr. Klemmer reinforced procurement governance across one of the federal government's largest healthcare systems, strengthening acquisition rigor and capital stewardship supporting millions of veterans and thousands of facilities nationwide.

At the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers, he directed capital delivery execution across highly visible civil works and defense infrastructure programs funded through special congressional appropriations, preserving compliance integrity under sustained public accountability.

Mr. Klemmer currently serves as Director of Procurement for Gallup-McKinley County Schools, where he is fortifying public sector procurement architecture through disciplined compliance systems, capital oversight controls, and transparency frameworks designed to protect fiscal integrity and reinforce public trust.

He holds a Master of Business Administration and a Bachelor of Science in Business Administration, graduating summa cum laude. A Certified Procurement Officer and author of *Strategic Synergy* and *Infinite Potential Leadership*, he advances a systems-based philosophy of institutional stewardship grounded in disciplined execution, structural alignment, and long-horizon public value.
